Dear Parent /Guardian:

On Wednesday October 12th, all students in grades 10 and 11 will participate in the administration of the Preliminary SAT (PSAT). The *Official Student Guide to the PSAT* which includes test taking tips and a practice test has been distributed in grades 10 and 11 English classes. There is **no charge** or **registration** procedure necessary for the PSAT. Students in grades 9 and 12 will participate in special programming with a delayed start to their school day. Period one will not occur on Wednesday, October 12th.

Grades 10 & 11

The PSAT will start promptly at **8:00 AM**. Students will report directly to their testing rooms which will be posted a few days prior to testing in their English classes, as well as the Main Office and Guidance Services. At the conclusion of the test, all students will report to their homeroom.

The PSAT is the best preparation for the SAT reasoning test. All students who take the PSAT will receive a personalized score report clearly indicating areas that may need attention in preparing for the SAT.

Grades 9 and 12

Students in grades 9 and 12 will report to school at **9:30 AM**. All grade 9 students will report to Auditorium through the exterior main entrance. All grade 12 students will report to the Gym. At the conclusion of the program, all students will report to their homerooms.
